

Annual Report for the Youth Committee, 2007

The following is the activity of the Youth Committee for 2007:

- Minor maintenance of the committee blog was made to address personnel changes for 2007. The address for the blog is (still):

- The committee did not hold an in-person meeting in 2007. The committee did not hold a meeting with all of its members present in 2007— All communication occurred electronically or between smaller groups of its members.
- As mentioned in last year's annual report, the committee helped to organize a meeting between Woodbury and First: Fairfield to talk about Triennium on February 11, 2007. Committee member David Roberson was in attendance representing the Youth Committee.
- Of the two goals that committee attempted to accomplish for in 2007:
 1. To facilitate attendance by members of our Presbytery at Youth Triennium 2007
 2. To create an electronic survey "needs assessment" for the various churches in our Presbytery

only the first of those goals was met. The youth committee helped to facilitate a delegation of 12 people representing three different churches within the Presbytery to attend the Triennium. The committee also worked with First: Fairfield youth director Adam Harbaugh to lead worship at a 2007 Presbytery meeting with Triennium participants. No work has yet begun on the second goal.

- The youth committee did not make any requests for action on the floor of Presbytery for 2007.
